damon connolly 2nd vice president supervisor district 1 **SUMMARY:** The attached monthly report provides an overview of Marin Transit operations for the period ending March 31, 2017. These reports summarize statistics on the performance of Marin Transit services, customer comments, and training activities under the District's Mobility Management program.

judy arnold director supervisor district 5 Ridership levels in March 2017 were relatively consistent with the prior year. Ridership on fixed-route services, including yellow bus, increased 1.0% compared to last year. In particular, Saturday and Sunday ridership on fixed-route services increased significantly (+24%) compared to last year. This corresponds to the increase in the amount of weekend service provided (+21%) after the June 12, 2016 service changes.

kate colin director city of san rafael

Ridership on Marin Access services dropped 3.0%. Most of this reduction in ridership was on Local Paratransit and Catch-A-Ride.

dennis rodoni director supervisor district 4 Staff will present additional detailed analyses of system performance and trends, including route-level statistics and financials, in separate quarterly and annual reports.
