kathrin sears director supervisor district 3 **SUMMARY:** The attached monthly report provides an overview of Marin Transit operations for the period ending September 30, 2017. The monthly reports summarize statistics on the performance of Marin Transit services, customer comments, and training activities under the District's Mobility Management program.

Ridership in September 2017 dropped 4.6% compared to September 2016. Ridership on fixed-route services decreased 4.8% compared to the same month last year. This was partly due to two fewer school days. There was also a significant drop in Muir Woods Shuttle ridership, despite an additional day of service compared to last year. This is likely because two of the three changeable message signs have not been operational. Ridership on Marin Access services had a modest decline of 1.5%, primarily on the volunteer driver program.

Additional detailed analyses of system performance and trends are provided in separate quarterly and annual reports, including route-level statistics and financials. These reports are available on the District's website at http://marintransit.org/monitoringreports.html.
